Year 8 'The Animal Man' - Thursday 22nd February 2024

Year 8 Geography students are being given the opportunity to take part in an interactive Animal presentation on **Thursday 22nd February 2024**, to complement their study of 'Our Living World' during the spring term. All students involved will experience a presentation in school lasting one hour and will have the opportunity to hold and pet the animals, if willing to take part.

Animals for the show include tarantulas, snakes, lizards, and two of the following mammals: coatis (tree bears), raccoon dog, baby silver fox, giant European rabbits, skunks, and/or an owl.

There will be an option for students to leave the room if uncomfortable with a particular animal/reptile during the presentation without the need to be excluded from the whole experience.
