## The day of the trip

This trip will take place on **Friday 8<sup>th</sup> March 2024**. There are two sessions, so students will either leave at approximately 8.45am for the 9.30am session or 10.45am for the 11.30am session. Exact departure and return timings will be communicated to students closer to the event. Students will need to attend in full school uniform and bring everything they would normally need for their school day such as equipment and books.

## **ParentPay and Consent**

Tickets are subject to availability. This trip **is limited to 30 places** and the tickets will be offered on a first come, first served basis, and will be available from **Tuesday 27<sup>th</sup> February at 4.30pm**. Please note that due to the school having to purchase tickets in advance, the payment is non-refundable. The ticket cost is **£7.00** and includes entry to the event, transportation, and a signed copy of *COSMIC*. Payments for this trip close on **Tuesday 5<sup>th</sup> March 2024**.

There will be a consent form within ParentPay which you will need to fully complete to enable your child to go on this visit. It is very important that <u>all</u> the information requested on the ParentPay questionnaire is



completed, including emergency contact details, necessary medical information, and <u>full</u> doctors phone number.

You have previously received your ParentPay login details but if you have forgotten or mislaid these, you will need to go the ParentPay website (<u>www.parentpay.com</u>) and click "forgotten password". You will then be emailed a link to reset your account. Unfortunately, we are unable to do this in school.
