



How to Set up Microsoft Single Sign-on



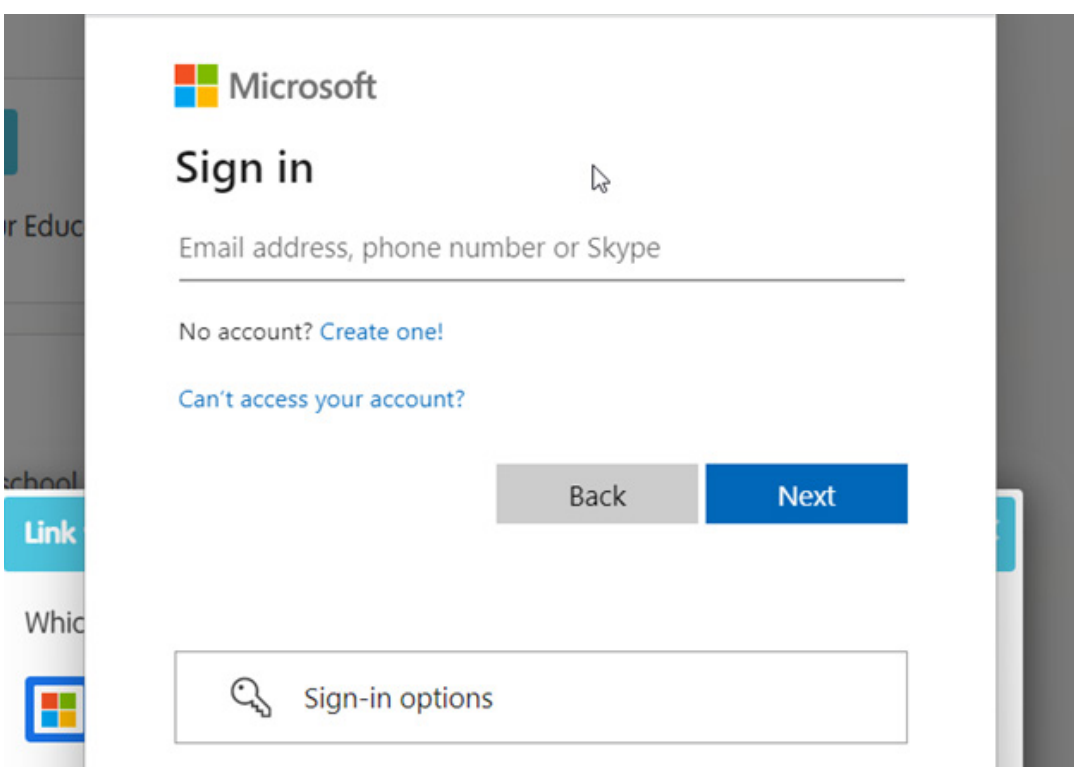
4. Re-enter your Educake password



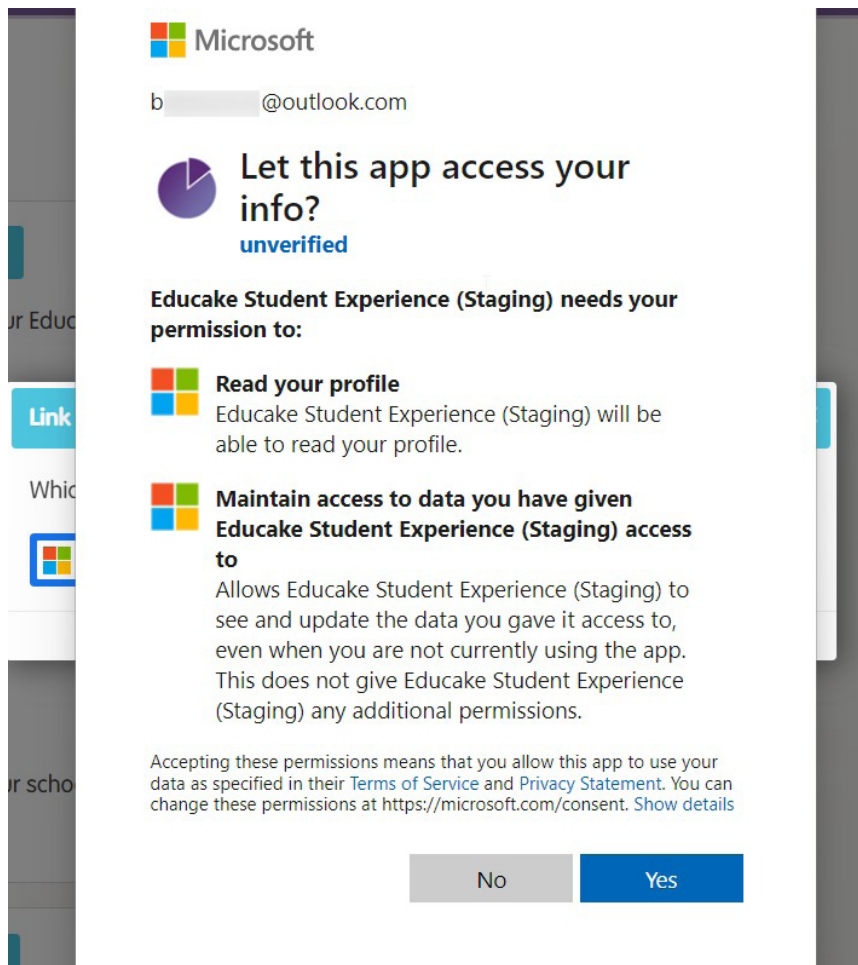
5. Confirm your chosen account



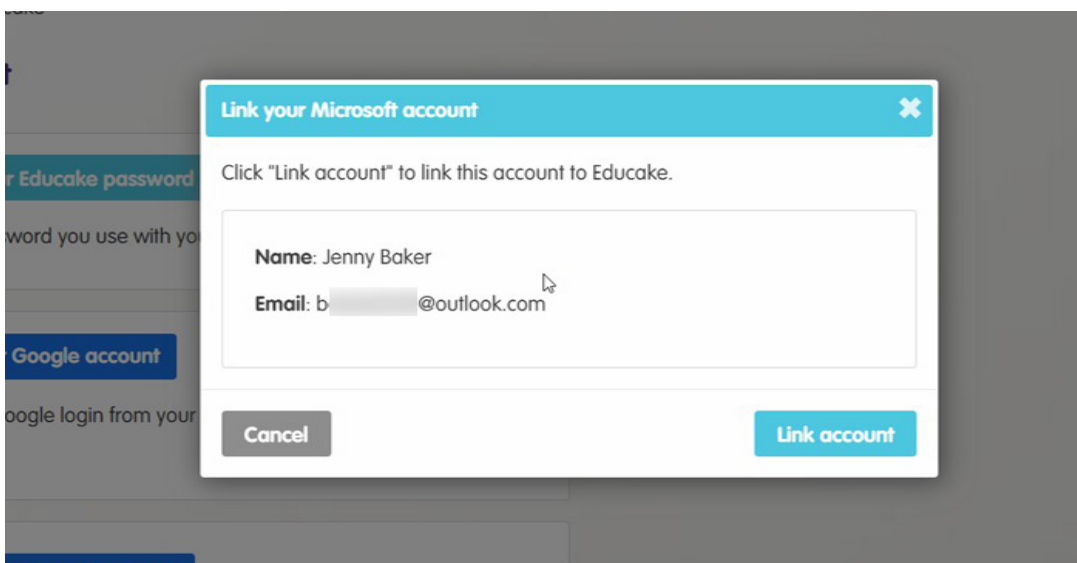
6. Enter your school email address and then password on the next page
