Mock Exam Results and Revision Packs

At Ridgewood, we are so proud of how well Year 11 students approached their Mock Exams earlier this term. It was clear from their reaction to the exams, but also in the quality of work they produced, that a great deal of work and preparation went into them. When students collected their results on Thursday, they were also given a Revision Pack, full of useful materials that will support the next stage of their learning journeys. The pack included...

- A CGP Maths Workbook (Higher or Foundation)

- A CGP guide to aid revision this includes Confidence Grids, Checklists, and Exam Timetables
- Two additional English revision resources (this is in addition to the texts provided to students last year)
- A highlighter and post-it notes

The Maths and Science workbooks should be brought into school for their Maths and Science lessons. Teachers will direct how these are to be used and may set homework using them. We made it very clear that these books are the responsibility of the students because of the positive impact they can have on learning. Thank you for your support in reinforcing this message at home with students.

Once again, I would like to offer a big well done to Year 11 for how well they performed in the Mock Exams. I have no doubt that they will continue to apply themselves impressively as they begin their final Ridgewood chapter!
