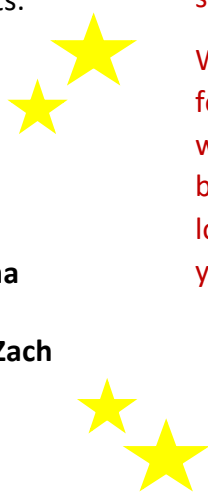

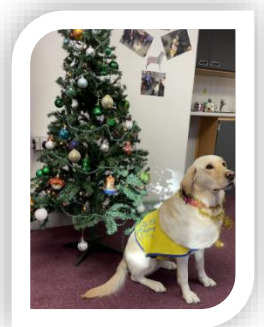


During the first few weeks in January, Miss Rose will be reviewing the newly released reports and updating action plans.
