

To Revise Maths We Do Maths

2 forms of revision:

- Targeted revision
- Random practice revision (Test)

Both are as important as each other.

Equipment:

- Pens.
- Pencils, rubbers and pencil sharpener.
- Ruler, protractor and pair of compasses.
- Scientific calculator (Casio).

Target the areas highlighted in yellow, these are the topic areas where some marks were awarded.

Test:

MathsWatch interactive questions on targeted areas.

CGP exam practice workbook questions on targeted areas.

Use practice papers, please only use those provided by school as we use real GCSE papers for mocks and monitor students' progress with them, identifying weak areas to concentrate on.
