The English Baccalaureate is a suite of qualifications that includes...

- English, Maths, Science
- A foreign language (French)
- History or Geography

This is because they are recognised by top colleges, universities, and employers, and having the Ebacc will place students in an advantageous position.

- Attend Options Evening on Thursday 8th February from 6pm.
- Make sure you have Parents Evening appointments booked (Thursday 22 February). This is chance to talk to teachers about whether their subject might be a good choice.
- Speak with your teachers; they know students well and will offer thoughtful advice about the next steps.
- Speak to Miss Broadhead and Mr Cannon who can also offer help and advice.

The classic "Do's and Do Not's" of Options...



- Do not pick a subject because you the like the teacher. We have lots of teachers who teach similar subjects so there is no guarantee you will get a particular teacher.
- Do not pick a subject because your friends are. We run lots of classes in the same subject so it is likely you would end up in a different group.
- Do not pick Music, Dance and/or Drama if you do not like performing in front of others.
- Do pick one of History, Geography, French, Computer Science, Triple Science... the blue subjects!
